Before this Loan Agreement is signed, the Quartermaster, or another committee member who is nominated by the Quartermaster, and a Trip Leader for a given Club Trip, shall both visually inspect the equipment to be loaned and be satisfied that there is no obvious damage. After the table on the second page is filled in, with all unused lines scored out, the Trip Leader shall sign the Loan Agreement to agree to the terms and conditions of the loan, as detailed here, and to confirm that he or she has received every one of the items listed on the second page.

OU Walking Club gives no warranty as to the appropriateness of the borrowed equipment, listed below, for the use to which it is intended to be put, and it is at all times the responsibility of the borrower to ensure, as far as is reasonably practical, that the borrowed equipment meets the needs of the intended use. Notwithstanding this, OU Walking Club would also expect that if the borrowed equipment is of a technical / mountaineering nature, which is denoted by the ‘Technical?’ box in the table below being initialed by the committee member, then it only be used in connection with any activity that complies fully with the rules of the British Mountaineering Council and regulations for that appropriate activity.

The loaned equipment is the property of OU Walking Club, therefore the Trip Leader shall undertake to be billed for the replacement cost of the equipment should it not be returned or is returned in a noticeably worse condition. On signing above, the Trip Leader accepts the following undertaking: *“in accepting the equipment and signing above I, the Trip Leader, confirm that I know how to operate the equipment, am aware of its limitations, and on signing this Loan Agreement accept total responsibility for its use by myself and others, and for its replacement, by my payment of a bill sent to me by OU Walking Club, in the event that it is not returned to OU Walking Club in the same condition as when it was borrowed”*.
