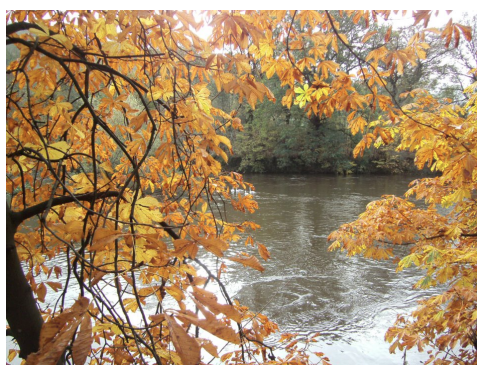


Tintern Abbey and Wye Valley Minibus day Trip
