

The Rhinogs

-wild camping-

Dates: 11th - 13th May (end of 3rd week)

There will be a pre-trip meeting early in 2nd week that you will have to attend in order to sort out gear, tent groups & buying food.

Depart: 4pm, Friday 11th, from Trinity gates. Return late on Sunday 13th.

Cost: £29 (+ food, stove fuel, etc)

This trip is a wild camping trip with a demanding route, mostly off path.

The Rhinogs form the southernmost tip of Snowdonia and are less well known than their northern counterparts. The rocky and remote terrain is varied and offers one of the wildest landscapes outside of Scotland, with the tallest peak (Y Llethr) standing at 756m. The Rhinogs are well suited to hillwalkers looking for an isolated, challenging experience.



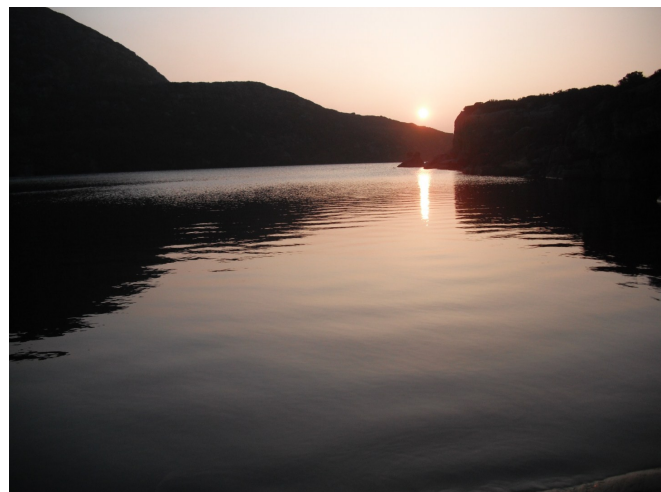
Equipment: Rucksack (at least 55L with a padded hip-strap), well worn in hiking boots, full waterproofs, headlamp, cutlery & crockery, small-packing sleeping bag, roll-mat/thermarest, tent & camping stove if possible.

Tents & Food: We will have a pub meal Friday & Sunday night for which you will need to bring cash. All other meals will be organised within individual tent groups. The tent groups will be decided at the pre-trip meeting and suggestions for feasible meals will be made.

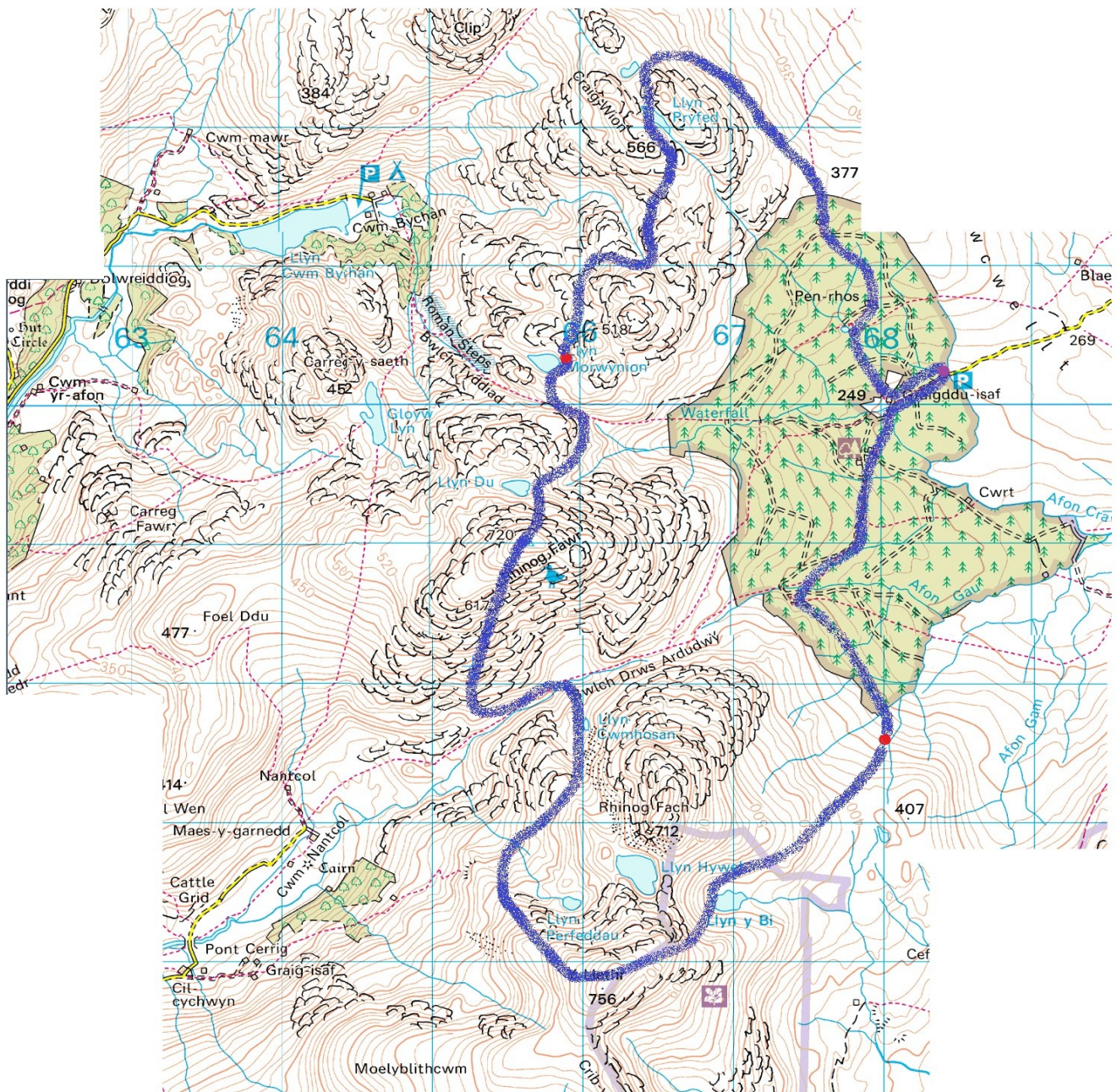
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Llyn Morwynion, our second campsite (taken last Easter)

This trip is a group of equals trip. All participants must be experienced walkers who are able to reliably navigate the route above, without being led.

We will be carrying all our tents, stoves, food, etc. while we walk.

Membership: As with all OUWC trips, you must become a member of the club to be allocated a place. We are only able to offer refunds on trips if we are able to fill the vacated place. There is a balloting procedure for oversubscribed trips. If necessary, we will give preference to people who can provide tents/stoves/etc for the trip.
