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Equipment: You will need a worn in pair of hiking boots and a comfy rucksack. You should come prepared for all weather conditions; the weather can be very unpredictable. A waterproof jacket and trousers are a must. You will need a sleeping bag (you can borrow a sleeping bag from the club on request). A full equipment list will be circulated to participants.

Food: We will stop on services with good food options or in pubs on Friday and Sunday evenings. Please bring enough money for two pub meals. All packed lunches and the dinner on Saturday are included in the trip.

Accommodation and walks: We will be staying in the George Starkey Hut is in Patterdale near Ullswater at the heart of the Lake District's Eastern Fells. It is ideally placed for the High Street range to the East, whilst from the front there is a splendid view of Helvellyn and its neighbouring fells: to reach them, all you have to do is put on your boots and walk from the Hut.
