(i) Motion 1: Motion to affiliate with the BMC in time for the start of the next academic year (MT08).

This summer we are planning to affiliate OUWC to the BMC for the next academic year. It has been noted in correspondence with both the University Insurance Department and the Area Safety Officer for sport that the University would like OUWC to affiliate to its National Governing Body, which is the British Mountaineering Council (BMC). A motion has been proposed to this TGM that the club affiliate to the BMC this summer, however this is subject to the BMC accepting our constitution and other policies and it is possible that our request for affiliation may be rejected.

If the TGM passes the motion to affiliate to the BMC **AND** our request for affiliation is rejected by the BMC, the Trip and Safety Coordinator in Michaelmas term is mandated to:

- Liaise with the OUWC president and the BMC as to what changes are necessary in order for us to affiliate
- Submit draft proposals for those changes to the committee no later than 4th week
- Submit motions to the TGM in Michaelmas term
- Ensure that the relevant documentation is sent to the BMC to ensure that the club affiliates at the beginning of Michaelmas term 2009
